Stitch Directory

Ch(s) - Chain(s)
Sc - Single Crochet
Dc - Double Crochet
St(s)
Stitch(ss)

St(s) - Stitch(es)

Inc - Increase (Do 2Sc)

Dec2tog - Decrease next 2 stitches together

Rnd - Round Nxt - Next Sl St - Slip Stitch

FLO Dec2tog - In Front Loops only, Decrease next 2 stitches together

Ch2-sp - Space created by previous row's Ch2

Materials

4.50mm Crochet Hook (US 7)
100g - Yellow Chunky Baby Wool
25g - Tan Brown Chunky Baby Wool
Small amount Black Chunky Baby Wool
Small amount of White Wool
Tapestry / Yarn Needle
Stitch Marker
Toy Stuffing

Pattern Notes

- Betty the Bumble Bee Blankie pattern is made using continuous rounds, unless otherwise stated. Ensure that you insert a stitch marker into the 1st stitch of each round, to keep an accurate note of your place in the pattern.
- Blankie is created by 19 hexagon motifs sewn together.
- Each Hexagon Motif approx. 3" wide.
- Finished Blankie 16" Hexagon.
- Pattern is suitable for an advanced beginner.

Warning

Young Children, toddlers should always be supervised when playing with this toy. There may be small pieces that the child can dislodge and the potential for ingestion or respiration injuries.

Please ensure that the wool used is safe for young children and that all pieces are securely attached to the toy firmly.

BLANKET MOTIFS - (Make 19)

Working in the Round (not continuous rounds)

Using Yellow & Tan Brown.

With Yellow.

Ch4, join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 - Ch3, 2Dc, Ch2, (3Dc, Ch2) 5 times. Join to 3rd ch of Ch3.



Rnd 2 - Sl st in next 2 sts, Ch3, 2Dc in ch2-sp, Ch2, 3Dc in same ch2-sp, (3Dc, Ch2, 3Dc, in nxt ch2-sp) 5 times. Join to 3rd ch of Ch3.



With Tan Brown. Rnd 3 - Sc in all sts, (48).

Finish with a sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off and secure all ends.





BODY - (Make 1).

With Black and Yellow.

Using Black,

Rnd 1 - Using the Magic Circle Method, Sc 6 (6) Pull to close

Rnd 2 - (Inc in nxt st) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3 - (Sc in nxt st, Inc in nxt st) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4 - (Sc in nxt 2 sts, Inc in nxt st) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5 - Sc in all sts (24)

Attach and use Yellow,

Rnd 6&7 - Sc in all sts (24)

Using Black,

Rnd 8&9 - Sc in all sts (24)

Using Yellow,

Rnd 10&11- Sc in all sts (24)

Using Black,

Rnd 12 - (Sc in nxt 2 sts, FLO Dec2tog) 6 times (18)

Rnd 13 - Sc in all sts (18)

Using Yellow,

Rnd 14&15 - Sc in all sts (18)

Secure the yellow wool tail.

Using Black,

Rnd 16 - (Sc in nxt st, FLO Dec2tog) 6 times (12)

Stuff your Betty.

Rnd 17 - (FLO Dec2tog) 6 times (6)

Fasten off, weave the wool tail through each of the front loops on previous row stitches and pull to close, then secure the end firmly.



WINGS (Make 2). With white.

Ch5, turn.


Row 1 - 8Dc in 3rd ch from the hook, sl st into last ch.

Fasten off and leave enough wool tail to secure the wing firmly to the body.



MAKING UP SECTION


Sew Blankie motifs together, set your motifs out as shown facing right side up.





Sew motifs together with Tan Brown Wool.

With work right side facing, use a tapestry needle to sew into the back loops only from one motif to the other. Gently pull the wool tight to close the join.



- 1 Starting with Motif 1, sew one side to Motif 2, other side to Motif 3, as shown in diagram above, then continue round motif 1 joining motifs 4, 5, 6 & 7.
- 2 Sew up the side of Motif 2 and 7, then continue around motif 2 joining motifs 8, 9, 10, then continue to sew up the opening between motif 2 and 3, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 3 Reattach wool at the joining point of motifs 2, 3 & 10. Sew up between motifs 3 and 10 then join motifs 11 & 12, then continue to sew up the opening between motifs 3 & 4, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 4 Reattach wool at the joining point of motifs 3, 4 & 12, Sew up between motifs 4 and 12 then join motifs 13 & 14, then continue to sew up the opening between motifs 4 & 5, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 5 Reattach wool at the joining point of motifs 4, 5 & 14, Sew up between motifs 5 and 14 then join motifs 15 & 16, then continue to sew up the opening between motifs 5 & 6, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 6 Reattach wool at the joining point of motifs 5, 6 & 16, Sew up between motifs 6 and 16 then join motifs 17 & 18, then continue to sew up the opening between motifs 6 & 7, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 7 Reattach wool at the joining point of motifs 6, 7 & 18, Sew up between motifs 7 and 18 then join motif 19 then continue to sew up the opening between motifs 7 & 8, fasten off and secure all ends.
- 8 Sew up the openings between motifs 8&9, 9&10, 10&11, 11&12, 12&13, 13&14, 14&15, 15&16, 16&17, 17&18, 18&19, 19&8.

Attach wings to the body and give your Betty a face.





Attach Betty's body to the blanket's middle motif.
